changing our name to Woodside but I refuse to give

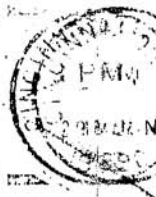
up Salt so it would be Salt Woodside - sounds like an

tance of Being Earnest.

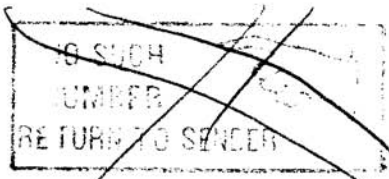
Maybe will make it back to Ohio if our family
